I. Scholarship Details:

Scholarships are for high school students entering college for the 2008-2009 academic year.

Award Amount:

I. Six Four-Year Scholarships for \$1,000 per year for <u>four</u> years. II. Two New Immigrant Scholarships for \$1,000 per year for <u>two</u> years.

Distribution Method: A check will be sent directly to the college or university to assist the award recipient with enrollment expenses.

Scholarship focus: Merit (Academic) and Need-Based Scholarship

II. Selection Criteria to be Considered:

- o Must be a full-time student.
- Priority is given to those with financial need.
- Financial data must be submitted as evidence of financial need.
- o Evidence of student's outstanding academic performance. Must have a 3.5 or higher GPA.
- o Extracurricular/Community Service: Should have participated in school clubs or community.
- Leadership: Show leadership either in their extra curricular activities or in winning awards.
- One letter of recommendation: Must provide letter of recommendation from someone who has personal knowledge of the student such as a teacher or student advisor.
- o An essay or a personal statement that may discuss the applicant's interest or reasons for applying this scholarship.

III. Application Materials

- o Completed Scholarship Application
- o Evidence of Financial Need
 - Applicant must submit a copy of their parent/guardian's IRS income tax return for past two years.
 - Student Aid Report section of FAFSA (a summary of what the FAFSA determines--family income, # of people in family and the estimated family contribution.)
 - If the applicant does not have the above-mentioned tax forms, he/she needs to provide any supplement supporting document(s) demonstrating financial need.
- o Official school transcript
- o SAT I score sheet (TOEFL score may also be submitted in addition to SAT score or if no SAT score is available)
- One letter of recommendation
- Essay or personal statement (12 point font and no more than 3 pages in length)
- o Any other materials applicant would like to include to show extracurricular involvement, leadership, or special qualification.
