大學排名 哈佛重登榜首

12年來首次獨享殊榮 普林斯頓居次 耶魯緊跟 並同享「最划算」前三名

【美聯社北卡羅來納州各羅二十一日電】「美國新聞與世界報導」(U. S. News & World Report)週刊22日公布2009年美國大學排名，全美歷史最悠久、最富有利招生最嚴格的哈佛大學重登榜首，而且12年來首次獨享這份榮譽。

普林斯頓大學連續八年高踞榜首後降為第二，耶魯大學緊跟在後，麻省理工學院和史丹福大學共列第四。加州理工學院和賓州大學共列第六，哥倫比亞大學、杜克大學和芝加哥大學共列第八。最新一期美新週刊將於25日上市，但是最新大學排名22日便已在該週刊網站公布。柏克萊加州大學名列第21，是排名最高的公立大學。在人文學院排名中，艾赫斯特(Amherst)學院非名升高，與同在麻州的威廉斯學院並列最佳人文學院，東克斯摩(Swarthmore)學院名列第三。排名前二名的商學院為賓州大學華頓(Wharton)管理學院、麻省理工學院史隆(Sloan)管理學院，根據學校素質、財務補助和讀書費用而編製的最划算大學排名中，前三名分別為哈佛、普林斯頓和耶魯。

哈佛文理學院發言人密契爾(Robert Mitchell)表示，獲得這份殊榮很好，但是該校招生人員一向告訴學生，應選擇符合自己需要的大學，而不是只考慮排名。排名方式考慮入學考試、同儕聲譽、招生嚴格程度和校友捐款等因素。哈佛在班級人數這一項超越普林斯頓，上課班級人數低於賓大的學生，從去年的69%升至75%，而班級人數多於50人的學生比率則從13%降至9%。被問到哈佛是否刻意縮減班級規模，密契爾說：「我們非常努力，以強化大學生的求學經驗。」從2000年以來，哈佛增加了86個新生研討班(不超過12個學生)、逾百名可獲終身職的教授，但是

班級人數大致相同。
